



KDT900 – Disabling the Touchscreen

Introduction

In some instances it might be desirable to disable the touchscreen interface of the KDT900. This document describes how to disable the touchscreen.

Registry Editing

The Windows Embedded CE 6.0 registry database holds settings and configuration data for the operating system. The registry can be edited with registry import applications like PlatformStartup.exe or over ActiveSync through remote registry programs.

AML recommends using the free CERegEditor by mdSoft for editing registry keys over ActiveSync.

Disabling the Touchscreen

The main touchscreen driver key is:

HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE/Drivers/AML/Touch

Setting the **Enable** value to 0 (zero) will disable the touchscreen. Setting to any other value will enable normal touchscreen operation.
