

KDT900 – Importing Registry Keys

Introduction

The KDT900 can automatically import Windows Embedded CE Registry Keys into the operating system's registry on boot.

.reg Files

During a cold boot sequence, the KDT900 will search the "Startup" subdirectory of the internal SD card (mounted as "Storage Card") for all files that end with a ".reg" file extension. ".reg" files should be ANSI encoded text files. The KDT900 will load all ".reg" files located in the "Startup" directory, but no order of import can be guaranteed.

.reg File Format

The KDT900 uses the standard Microsoft format for registry entry files, however the import will only handle DWORD and string values. For more information on the file format, visit: http://support.microsoft.com/kb/310516

Example Registry Entries

[HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Drivers\AML\Magstripe] "Enable"=dword:1

[HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Init] "Launch99"="PlatformStartup.exe"

There is no way to delete previously imported keys.
