## Addressing the scoreboard with either Hex or ASCII values

The ADI310 scoreboard requires different addressing based upon the data format used.

- If Standard Toledo Continuous called MultiContinuous1 is used, addresses must be entered as HEX characters (01-05) for Scales A-E
- For all other ASCII strings such as the new Extended Continuous Output, addresses must be entered as Decimal characters (65-69) for Scales (A-E)

These details will be included in the updated version of the manual.

Note: Termination resistors are not necessary, the ADI310 has internal termination resistors.
