Bating of Apparatus: 300 lbs.


Application:- Ammsement trade.

Description: The machine originally approved in Circular W.& M. #538 was manufactured by the Pace Manufacturing Company, Chicago, under the name of "Bentam" Personal Weigher. Change of owner-ship has been accompanied by changes in the shape of the body design, and the use of aluminum instead of cast iron for the pillar casting, but the weighing mechanism is identical with that originally approved.
