NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as a Class A device, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable to this classification.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Model 9658 Counter-Computing-Platform Cylindrical Chart Scale (Standard), manufactured by the Berkel Products Company, Limited, Toronto, Ont.

Rating of Apparatus: 30 lbs. maximum capacity.

Application: Weighing of commodities in general trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 3459.

Description: The scale is operated by a spring and lever type of mechanism provided with jewel bearings and tool steel knife-edges. Zero adjustment, levelling devices and adjustable dash-pot are provided. The platform has four point support. The mechanism is enclosed in porcelain steel casings and the split-drum type of chart is arranged for angle reading with only the weight readings being visible on the customer's side. Optional equipment may include: 15 lb. chart having price ranges from 9¢ to \$1.25 per lb. inclusive; 24 lb. chart having price ranges from 4¢ to 75¢ per lb. inclusive or from 5¢ to \$1.00 per lb. inclusive; 30 lb. chart having price ranges from 3¢ to 60¢ per lb. inclusive; porcelain steel platter or porcelain steel vegetable pan or porcelain steel fish pan.

Testing: The standard tests for a Counter-Computing-Platform-Cylindrical Chart scale will apply.
