NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act, the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as a Class C device, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable to this classification.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Model FFF Automatic Bagging Scale, manufactured by Richardson Scale Company, Clifton, N. J.

Rating of Apparatus: 200 lbs. maximum capacity.

Application: Bagging of such materials as rice and sugar in general trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in Part II, Sections 3 and 4 of P.C. 3459.

Description: This machine is provided with an equal-arm weighing mechanism which operates on the gravity principle and is equipped with hardened steel knife-edges and bearings. The discharge gate to the scale hopper is operated automatically by counter-weights and the discharge to the bag may be arranged for either automatic or manual control. A reserve of material fed from a separate compartment in the hopper allows uniform dribble flow. The discharge and dribble controls are adjusted by check-weighing with a Class A device.

Testing: Not applicable as Class C devices do not require
Government inspection; but notice should be taken of
the requirements of Part VI, Section 28 of P.C. 3459
respecting usage.


