NOTIFICATION OF LISTING

Under the previsions of the apprepriate Act, the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as a Class A device, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable to this classification.

Authority: Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 212, R.S. 1927, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 3459).

Apparatus Listed: Steelyard, Serial #A2000 manufactured by W. & T. Avery Company, Limited, Birmingham, England.

Rating of Apparatus: 300 lbs. capacity.

Application: Weighing cheeses and other bulk commodities in general trade.

Conditions: Approval granted for one steelyard, the property of The Department of Agriculture.

Description: This weighing device is similar in general design to the ordinary single beam steelyard used for checking the weight of wholesale quantities of goods. The beam is very well finished and is graduated in 2 lb. graduations. The beam also has a fractional poise located between the fulcrum pivot and the load pivot. This section of the beam has a capacity of 2 lb. and is graduated in 4 cs. graduations.

Testing: The standard tests for a steelyard type scale shall apply.
