## NOTIFICATION OF TYPE LISTING

Under the provisions of the appropriate Act, the apparatus specified herein has been listed, the prototype approved, and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Authority: Chapter 36, S.C. 1951 and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894).

Apparatus Listed: Yardstick, Model 350 M.E. manufactured by the Acme Rule and Advertising Company, Limited, 512 Rhodes Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

Rating of Apparatus: Capacity one yard.

Application: Measuring commodities in general trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894, and in addition the following "requirements" are mandatory:

 The markings on the yardsticks to be identical with the prototype.

(2) The straightness of the edge not to deviate

more than 1/16" from a straight line.
(3) The straightness of the flat side not to

(3) The straightness of the flat side not to deviate from a straight line more than 1/8".

The yardsticks may be distributed without original inspection provided they are marked "Legal for Trade" in the same manner as the prototype.

Description: The yardsticks are of varnished maple fitted with brass plated steel ends. The metal ends are affixed to the ends of the yardstick by a metal grommet passing through holes in the wood and metal and rivetted.

The sticks are 1 1/8" wide and 1/4" thick and are graduated on both sides, the graduations being along opposite edges.

The stick is marked in 1/8" graduations and each inch graduation is stamped with the appropriate numeral from 0 to 36".

Testing: The standard tests for a yardstick shall apply.
