Rating of Apparatus: As shown above.

Application: Weighing of commodities in general trade.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894 with the additional requirement that a level indicating device be installed on each scale to facilitate levelling of the scale.

Description: These devices are platform scales equipped with an automatic weight indicating head of the weightograph type. The head is similar in design to Model 77 except that a balance ball is provided to compensate for minor changes in balance. Levelling feet are provided to enable the scale to be maintained in a level position. The scale leverage system is composed of two T shaped levers, the long lever acting as the transfer lever. The platform is supported by a frame

which is suspended below the levers from the lever load pivots. Bearings are hardened and self aligning, the pivots are pear shaped with turned shanks which are fitted into reamed holes.

Testing: The standard tests for an automatic indicating scale of the platform type shall apply.
