APPROVAL LISTING

Prepackaging Counter Scales - Manufactured by Berkel Products Company, Limited, Belgium, for Berkel Products Company, Limited, 2199 Bloor Street West, Toronto, Ontario.

Under the provisions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C. 6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Prepackaging computing counter scale, Model 1315 with a capacity of 18 lbs.

Application: Weighing of commodities for prepackaging purposes.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C. 6894, with the added mandatory requirement that each scale bears a legend to the effect that the device is "IEGAL FOR PREPACKAGING USE ONLY & NOT FOR DIRECT SALES TO THE CUSTOMER". The legend must be located in a position plainly visible to an observer and of a permanent nature with letters at least 3/16" in height on a contrasting background. The scales must not be used on the retail premises of a business enterprise.

Description: This device is a counter computing sylinder chart, spring and lever scale, graduated in 1/8 ounce graduations. The price range is from 11 cents to \$1.75 with one cent graduations. The images of weight and total price are light beamed through two separate lens combinations and projected on two separate screens. The magnification of price and weight is 4.25 and 5.5 respectively. The resistance to weight is supplied by two sets of paired temperature compensating springs. The leverage system is as shown on the reverse side of this circular. Bearings are V type agate. The large bakelite disc on the right hand side of the casing is for quick adjustment of price and immediately below is the tare knob which must be pressed in to engage. Zero adjustment is accomplished with a screwdriver through a hole in the front casing panel which is screened by the vertical flashing of the load pan. The scale is equipped with a temperature compensated dash
