Pertable Platform scale - manufactured by Bizerba - Waagen - Verkauf G.M.B.H., Balingen (Wurtt) Postfach 107, Germany.

Under the previsions of the Weights and Measures Act, Chapter 292, R.S.C. 1952, and Regulations thereunder (P.C.6894), the apparatus specified and illustrated herein has been listed as an approved device and may be used in Canada in accordance with the conditions applicable.

Apparatus Listed: Pertable platform dial scale model W.F. type 240.

Rating of Apparatus: Capacity 900 lbs.

Application: Weighing commodities in trade, shipping and industrial use.

Conditions: As prescribed in P.C.6894.

Description: This device is a pertable platform dial scale equipped with four rubber tired wheels for pertability and four adjustable levelling feet for weighing. The registering dial is graduated to 600 lbs. x 8 sunces graduations. The dial head is equipped with twin pendulum resistance weights, each with one piece double sectors and guides and are controlled by steel tapes. The tare dial 150 lbs. I 8 ownces graduations is controlled by a kneb on the front of the cabinet and tare registration appears in a window near this knob. A drep weight adds 150 lbs. to the tare dial capacity when required and the additional weight appears in a window in line with the tare indicating line. A chain type zero balance unit is installed on the scale. The underdeck leverage system consists of two pipe type steel fabricated levers with extension arms linked to a transfer lever. The transfer lever has a cross bar with a fulcrum pivot in each end bearing upward against fulcrum bearings secured in arms supported by the frame. The relieving gear when in locked position locks the tare beam against the lever steps and the pendulums against their stops and unlecks the wheels. The relieving gear lever is located on the back
