- 2. The location and serial number of each device sold must be reported to the Chief, Weights and Measures by the manufacturer.
- 3. All devices covered by this approval shall be retrofitted before the expiry date of this approval so that the following areas of non-compliance have been corrected:
- Cancellation of tare mode by depressing Tare key. is contrary to section 14.5 of Ministerial Specification SGM1.
- Excess range of auto zero maintenance. This is contrary to section 13.3 of Ministerial Specification SGM1.
- 4. These devices are exempt from section 15 of Ministerial Specification SGMl for any weight up to 0.2 pounds placed on the platter.
- This approval to be replaced by a special approval after all retrofitting has been completed. The manufacturer to advise the Chief, Weights and Measures when all retrofits have been completed.
