Apparatus Listed: Prepackaging Computing Counter Scale, Model OF-15F.

Rating of Apparatus: Capacity 15 pounds.

Application: Weighing commodities for prepackaging purposes.

Special Conditions: Each scale must bear the legend "Legal for Prepackaging Use Only and Not For Direct Sales To The Customer". The legend must be located in a position plainly visible to an observer and it must be of a permanent nature with letters at least 3/16" in height on a contrasting background. These scales shall not be installed on the retail premises of any business enterprise unless in a prepackaging room separate from the retail area.

<u>Description</u>: This device is a prepackaging counter computing scale employing light beams, and a transparent chart whose movement is so synchronized with the scale movement as to allow two systems of condenser and projection lenses with mirrors to be used for projecting images of weight and total price on a screen. The reading line is a definitive colour separation reading edge. The price per pound is set manually by the two operating levers on the side of the scale. This device utilizes four main load bearing supports and dual opposed penculums as the resistance. The chart reticule is mounted directly on one of the pendulum levers.

Testing: The standard tests for a prepackaging counter scale shall apply.
