Apparatus Listed: Toledo Hanging Scale with single revolution dial, model 2110.

Rating of Apparatus: Capacities 30 pound, 60 pound, 120 pound, 25 killograms and

50 killograms.

Application: Weighing commodities in general trade.

Description: This device is a single revolution suspended spring type dial scale. The resistance to the load is provided by four helical wound, temperature compensated springs, each suspended vertically from the hanger plate. The lower ends of the springs are anchored to the load bridge by adjustable spring clamps. Dampening is effected by an air cylinder type dash pot.

Commodity equipment can be either round pan, hook, scoop, and lap pan.

Testing: The standard tests for a suspended dial scale shall apply.
