
Description:


This scale is electronic digital type with price computing facilities. The weight sensing element is of the vibrating string type which utilizes the method of mass comparison to perform the weighing function. The sensing element has a pair of bronze wires which are subjected to tension loadings by means of a known preload force and by a force directly proportional to the load on the weight platter. Vibrations are generated in the wires by means of electromagnets which are energized by the electronic system of the scale. Weight is determined by comparing the frequencies of the two vibrating wires.

The weighing mechanism and the control and readout system are enclosed in separate housings which are connected by an electrical cable. Unit price settings are made by the use of a pushbutton console at the front of the control/readout unit. Total price computation is performed by the scale electronic system. Weight, unit price, and total price are displayed by means of numeral tubes.

The scale frames and load support members are principally of steel construction. Housings are of moulded plastic material. The load platform is of stainless steel.
