Description: These are fully electronic checkstand scales, with a pod mounted weight display.

The construction, circuits and load cell are the same as those in the stand alone scale models SL41-30WK and SL42-15WK approved on S.WA-1149 with the exception that this scale is fitted with an interface board to make it compatible with an Electronic Cash Register. When interconnected to a TEC ECR the suffix NF is added to the scale model number, i.e. SL41-30 NF, when interconnected to a NCR ECR model number is shown as SL41-30 NH.

Approved Accessories: The following is a list of electronic cash registers which are specially approved for installation with the Tec Models SL41-30 and SL42-15 scales if initially verified on or before the expiry date. No additional installations are allowed after the expiry date.


Special Conditions of Approval:

- *1. The Tec Model MA-190-30 Cash Register shall be field retrofitted as shown below subject to the availability of components.
- (a) The ECR shall be modified so that when the amount of weight is displayed, it shall also display the units of measurement i.e., lb or kg.

Testing: The weight display can be verified with the OFF/ON switch. When switched ON the display will cycle through the display indicators from 1 to 0 and the Zero indication light will light.

The standard test for an electronic checkstand scale will apply.

The Tec Model MA-190-30 ECR display can be checked by keying in 8's.



Conditions of Approval: 1. The devices are exempt from SGM 1/12.

Approval is granted under the Weights & Measures Act. S.C. 1970-71-72, Chapter 36, and the Weights & Measures Regulations C.R.C. c., 1605 for use in Canada under the general conditions of the said Regulations, and under any special conditions listed above.
